### ***I. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS***

Chairman Kenny Wilson welcomed the guests and members of the Transportation Committee to the meeting.

### ***II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES***

Chairman Wilson referred the Committee to the minutes of the July 12, 2017 meeting as printed on pages 1-3 of the meeting packet.

**Mr. Richard Roof made a motion to accept the Minutes as presented and was seconded by Mr. Arthur Boykin. The motion passed unanimously.**

### ***III. REVIEW FY18 GOALS AND OBJECTIVES, COMMITTEE BYLAWS***

Chairman Wilson called on Stacey Courtney to review the FY18 Goals and Objectives and the Committee Bylaws. Mr. Courtney directed attention to the FY18 Goals and Objectives and the Committee Bylaws printed on pages 4 through 6 of the meeting packet. He reported that the documents had been provided to each committee member prior to the meeting for their review.

**Mr. Arthur Boykin n made a motion to accept the FY18 Goals and Objectives as presented. Mr. Dwayne Stice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.**

**Mr. Arthur Boykin made a motion to accept the Committee Bylaws as presented. Mr. Bill Miller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.**

### ***IV. MAJOR TRAFFIC GENERATION***

Chairman Wilson called on Mr. Courtney to give a report on major traffic generators. Mr. Courtney directed attention to the hand out for each county showing the major traffic generators provided to the committee members prior to the meeting. Mr. Courtney welcomed feedback from the committee members. He noted that he would compile the information to make maps depicting the traffic generators for each county. He noted that the report was due to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet by April 1, 2018.

### ***V. DISTRICT 1 – PROJECT UPDATES***

Mr. Mike McGregor, Kentucky Transportation Cabinet District 1 Chief Engineer, provided an update on the I-69 Corridor starting at Fulton and moving up to Calvert City.

### ***VI. OTHER BUSINESS***

Chairman Wilson called on Mr. Mark Davis to give a report on the 2018 FEMA Hazard Mitigation Plan. Mr. Davis reported that the PADD was currently updating the plan. The plan continues to identify long term Hazard Mitigation measures that will help to reduce the loss of life and damage to property from natural disasters. As part of this process, staff has worked with each jurisdiction to assess potential threats. Mr. Davis asked if anyone had any input into the plan to please contact the PADD staff.

Chairman Wilson asked if there were any updates from airports, riverports or transit. Mr. Richard Roof reported that SkyWest Airlines has been awarded another two-year contract to provide daily United Express jet service to and from Chicago out of Barkley Regional Airport. The contract takes effect Feb. 1 and runs through January 2020.

In conclusion, Mr. Roof stated that Barkley Regional has a Master Plan Update replacing new signage of about 65 units on the airfield. They will also be re-milling and resurfacing several taxi runways when weather permits.

Mr. Arthur Boykin announced the Paducah Transit Authority will be disposing of approximately 25 vehicles. Included in these vehicles will be 7 cut away vehicles as well as 7 mini vans, that are ADA accessible. The vehicles will go through a bid process on eBay starting in January. Mr. Boykin added that if anyone had any questions, to please contact him.

In addition, Mr. Kenny Etherton stated that the Fulton County Transit Authority currently has four vehicles for bid on eBay. The bidding for their vehicles will start today and end in five days.
